## Regarding trade compliance and EU: s 11<sup>th</sup> sanctions package

EU has adopted an 11<sup>th</sup> package of sanctions against Russia. As of 30 September 2023, importers of sanctioned iron and steel goods that have been processed in a third country will need to prove that the inputs used does not come from Russia, as regulated in Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014, products listed in annex XVII.

Sifvert Skruv AB are committed to follow any trade restrictions adopted by EU and Sifvert Skruv continues to review and manage our supply chain to make sure we comply with trade sanctions.

Please take this letter as confirmation that SIFVERT SKRUV AB does not supply/ trade the following:

- Iron and steel products which are imported or purchased, directly or indirectly, from Russia as listed in Annex XVII
- Iron and steel products which are made from raw material or components which are sourced or processed, either directly or indirectly, from Russia
